The following paragraph can also be removed from the Horne report: "It is unclear why …" William IV was eldest son from the first marriage, while Dirk of Perwez was the eldest son from the second marriage.

In the lists of both te Boekhorst and van de Boel, Gerard II is missing, whereby te Boekhorst uses another numbering for Gerard.
