## 1.

The table on p. 8 contains an error: **cat. Type I B** has gothic **Ų**'s in the reverse outer legend, and the table should read as follows:

## 2.

Goddeeris is of the opinion that the genealogy work of Klaversma is likely to be the most historiucally accurate and complete. Goddeeris further opines that:

p. 58 (at the end) of the Horne report (ref. 1): “V.d. Boel says that Gerard I died in 1330, and that his second son William IV ...”

The word “second” can be deleted, because v.d. Boel does not say this.

The following paragraph can also be removed from the Horne report: “It is unclear why ...” William IV was eldest son from the first marriage, while Dirk of Perwez was the eldest son from the second marriage.

In the lists of both te Boekhorst and van de Boel, Gerard II is missing, whereby te Boekhorst uses another numbering for Gerard.
